Then, on the Our Father Beads say:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On the Hail Mary Beads say:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

In conclusion, say three times:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

MORNING OFFERING

O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer You my prayers, works, joys and sufferings of this day for all the intentions of Your Sacred Heart, in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world, in reparation for my sins, for the intentions of all my relatives and friends, and in particular for the intentions of the Holy Father. PRAYER TO ST. JOSEPH FOR PROTECTION
